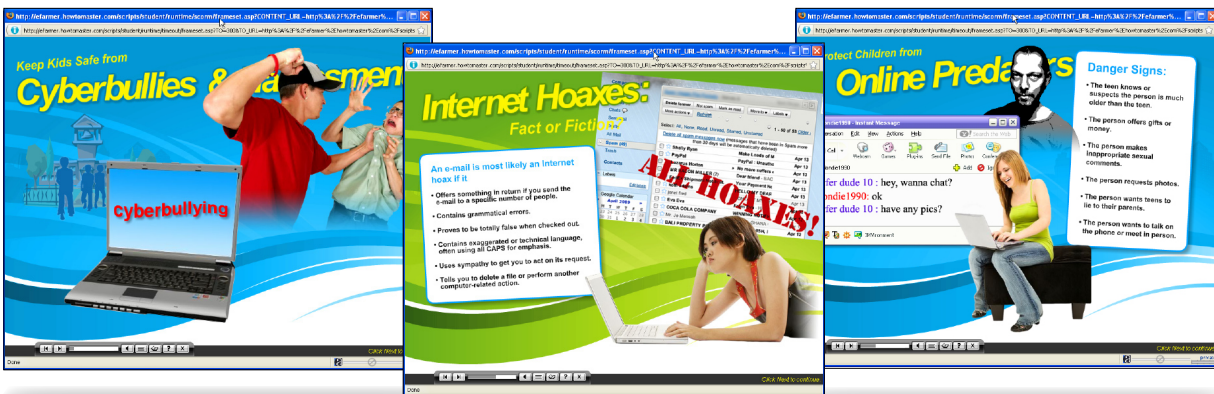


PROTECTING STUDENTS

ISSUES TEENS ARE FACING

- 20% of teens have sexted, and 81% of teen sexters are under 18 years old.
- 65% of 8-15 year olds have been involved in cyber bullying, 81% of teens think it's easy to get away with cyber bullying and to hide it from adults.
- 72% of teens have online profiles with personal information, making them an easier target for predators.
